

The project main goal is to enhance climate resilience and well-being for rural communities in Wag-Himra Zone, Amhara region. It focuses on improving food security, economic empowerment, and aligning government policies with community needs and priorities.

The project aims to contribute to increased climate resilience and well-being of rural communities in Wag Hemra Zone. It will focus on six major watersheds. The working approach will be watershed approach and will be tried to reach out more communities. In CARD II, replicating and ensuring adoption of successful practices will be pursued in order to reach to more (indirect) beneficiaries. CARD II is gradually shifting from direct implementation to facilitation by heavily involving government actors in project implementation. The project works with the government, the private sector, and communities to ensure sustainable impact.

KEY TARGETS



The project will address directly 12,400 rural Households in six woredas (six major watersheds) of Wag-Hemra zone with a total of 63,000 men, women, girls and boys. The primary stakeholders are the Departments of Agriculture; Livestock Resource Development; Women and Children Affairs, Zonal Cooperative office, Sekota Dry land and research agriculture centre.
