The overall aim of this second phase project is to strengthen household and community resiliency to climate change through the development of adaptive, absorptive and transformative capabilities.

KEY TARGETS



HELVETAS, Concern Worldwide (CWW) and the North Gondar Zonal Administration and its clusters, have formed a strategic partnership bringing together complementary competencies to address the complex nature of poverty in the zone. The project aims at system level change in the areas of natural resource management, livelihood, market access, nutrition and women empowerment. Our theory of change is grounded in the belief that strengthening household and community resilience to climate change is complex and requires change across four independent yet interlinked systems. Within each system the project aims for several high-level (at times overlapping) outcomes.

The project is in Amhara region North Gondar Zone, Debark and Janamora woredas.



The project has a watershed approach and targets 4090 HHs (20950 people) direct and 30600 HHs (153000 people) indirect beneficiaries.
