



Important Instructions Before using Hermetic Bags

- •Ensure that the maize is dried to moisture content of 13%
- •Ensure the maize is cleaned with no foreign materials
- •Make sure that the general environment of storage is clean including the room to reduce chances of infestation
- •Purchase from recognized agrodealers and ensure that the bags have no defects like holes.
- •Ensure that the bags are properly branded







Are composed of two distinct bags, the polypropylene (PP) woven outer bag and a multilayer inner liner.

Has two cords inside the liner for the closing the bags.

The multilayer liner is co-extruded with barrier layers preventing the passage of gases such as oxygen, carbon dioxide and water vapor.

There is no pesticide used during the manufacture of AgroZ Bags and their use is not recommended during the entire storage period
















The Grain Storage Pyramid In Tanzania
